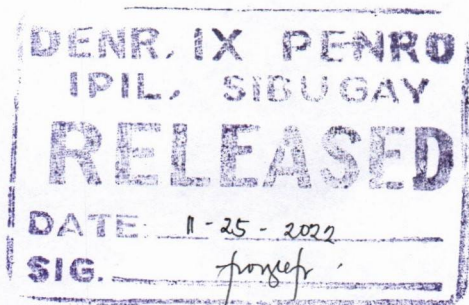

Subsequently, on November 26, 2022, Mr. Christopher Carcuera of Barangay Baganipay, Talusan, ZSP rescued and turned over one (1) adult Hawksbill turtle ( <i>Eretmochelys imbricata</i> ) with a curved carapace length of 47cm and a curved carapace width of 44cm. Since the prescribed curved carapace reached the required length, the Hawksbill turtle was tagged prior to its release. The tag was placed on the left flipper with the identification number <b>PH 0205 M</b> and <b>PH 0206 M</b> on the right flipper. The joint efforts of CENRO Imelda, PENRO Sibugay and LGU Talusan made it possible to tag and release this Critically Endangered reptile.


Please be informed that on November 10, 2022, the undersigned personnel from this Office under the *Conservation and Development Section-PAMBCU* coordinated with the Barangay Officials of Buluan, Magdaup and Zamboanga Sibugay Maritime Police Station stationed at Sitio Palid, Barangay Magdaup port area. The purpose of the coordination was to conduct monitoring on identified areas where marine sea turtles were mostly known to be rescued, tagged, rehabilitated and released.

Please be informed further, that during a dialogue with Barangay Officer of the day of Buluan in the person of Hon. Elma J. Bawisan, Barangay Kagawad of Buluan, Ipil, according to her recently they had not received any reports on coastal residents pertaining to marine sea turtles, also, through a similar dialogue at Barangay Magdaup, Ipil, the Barangay Secretary together with an assigned CVO informed the team that they also had not received any reports concerning marine sea turtles. In addition, the undersigned proceeded to Zamboanga Sibugay Maritime Police Station Port area, Sitio Palid, Magdaup, according to Police investigator Staff Sergeant Janus R Delonio during the period there has been no reports on sightings of any marine sea turtles. Based on the reports of no sightings the team suspected that the endangered reptiles may have temporarily moved to a different area, this was probably due to the recent pass of tropical typhoon "Paeng" which brought heavy rains and floods.


Continuous monitoring and coordination shall be conducted by the team to include the conduct of information education and communication campaign to local coastal communities and Barangay Officials pertaining to the protection and conservation of the threatened reptile and other DENR Laws, rules and regulations.

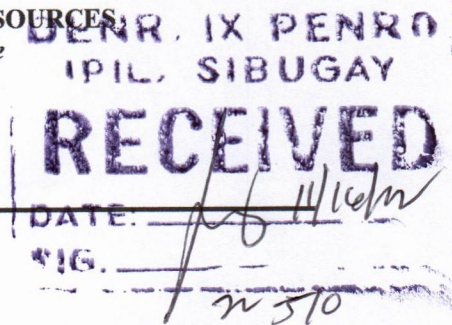
