**General location:** Canton Tessin (Ticino), 20 km N of the city of Lugano

**Altitude:** 200 m

**Overview:** One of the last-remaining intact natural deltas in Switzerland. Virgin banks and reedbeds on Lago Maggiore. Habitat and reproduction- and area for Batrachia (frog-spawning).

**Physical features:** Sandy soil with 6% CaCO<sub>3</sub>; decomposition of ferruginous minerals; mediterranean climate, hot summers and temperate winters, high quality of precipitation during the summer in the form of thunderstorms.

**Ecological features:** Reedbed, marsh with tall sedges, *megaphorbiae* (?); thickets and borders of *Salix*; riverine woodland in the transition areas between the lake and slow-flowing waterbodies; *Alnus* woods and borders.

**Noteeworthy flora:** *Thypha angustifolia*, *Sparganium simplex*, *Najas marina*, *Vallisneria spiralis*, *Agropyron litorale*, *Cyperus flavescens*, *Fimbristylis annua*, *Schoenoplectus triquetus*, *Eleocharis atropurpurea*, *Isolepis setacea*, *Carex pseudocyperus*, *Allium angulosum*, *Amaranthus deflexus*, *Ranunculus circinatus*, *Rorippa anceps*, *Rorippa amphibia*, *Frangaria moschata*, *Amorpha fruticosa*, *Trifolium pratense*, *Elatine hydropiper*, *Elatine hexandra*, *Hippuris vulgaris*, *Gratiola officinalis*, *Litorella uniflora*, *Artemesia verloterum*, *Senecio aquaticus*.
